



Living and slaughtering performances of Piemontese young bulls reared according to the organic farming method



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Aim

Is it possible to feed **fattening Piemontese young bulls** in respect of the organic production method (Reg. CE 1804/1999),

particularly regarding the rule that at least 60% of D.M. in the daily diet must be by fresh, dried or ensiled forages?

Material and methods

- •two groups (organic and traditional) of 10 Piemontese calves (about 8 months of age and 200 kg of l.w.);
- ·reared in the same environmental conditions up to the slaughtering weight (about 500 kg l.w.);
- ·fed with hay and concentrate for an ADG of 1.2 kg/d;
- •traditional (T): 2 kg/d of hay and increasing amount of concentrate (3.4 to 7.5 kg/d);
- •organic (O): increasing amount of hay (4.2 to 8.3 kg/d) and concentrate (2.2 to 3.8 kg/d).

Action

- ·to slaughter the traditional group and
- ·to complete the fattening period of the organic group not according to the organic rule of 60% D.M. by forages but like the traditional group (1 month of adaptation and 3 months of traditional feeding).

Other possibilities

- ·to study different diet, with more energetic forages (as maize silage);
- ·to improve the marketing and the selling price of organic cattle and meat (difficult for Piemontese breed, as price are already high).

Conclusion

For the Piemontese young bulls the adoption of the organic rearing method. according to the present rules and the normal length of the fattening period, does not allow to obtain a marketable product:

in fact, even if their live weight is adequate, the animals do not show a proper muscular development and fat cover
