Horses identification in France


- Identification tools today
 - Registration of natural markings :
 - White marks, whorls, blue eyes, ...
 - Text and /or codes (translation tool)
 - Hemotype (1976) then DNA (2000)
 - Registration of artificial markings (if any)
 - Fire / freeze branding
 - Micro chip code

All of them linked to a unique registration number
 for each horse : « SIRE Number → UELN »


Horses identification in France

- Mandatory identification started in
 2001 with a deadline for the end of 2002
 - 300 000 « new » horses registered from 2000 to 2004 (Unknown pedigree horses)
- Mandatory chipping started in 2004 with a deadline for the end of 2007
 - Foals and all new registrations in 2004
 - Stallions and broodmares in 2005
 - Racers and competitors in 2006
 - All the other horses living in France in 2007





An example of future application of database consultation





Chip code

With a special microchip, we will be able to read from a longer distance (today, only 20 centimetres)

Technology to read

- a lot of microchips in one time
- from a distance of 100 meters
